

CompTIA TECH CAREER ACADEMY'S MANDATORY COVID-19 VACCINATION POLICY

To protect the health and safety of CompTIA Tech's students, instructors and others in the surrounding community, CompTIA Tech requires that students enrolled in CompTIA Tech's in-person program(s) to be fully vaccinated for COVID-19 before attending same on any of CompTIA Tech's physical campuses.

To satisfy the foregoing requirement, effective June 21, 2021, all students enrolled in CompTIA Tech's in-person program(s) must obtain all dose(s) associated with a COVID-19 vaccine authorized and/or approved by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration ("COVID-19 Vaccine"), including:

- The Pfizer, Inc. and BioNTech COVID-19 Vaccine (BNT162b2) (i.e., both shots);
- The ModernaTX, Inc. COVID-19 Vaccine (mRNA-1273) (i.e., both doses); and
- The Janssen Pharmaceuticals Companies of Johnson & Johnson COVID-19 Vaccine (JNJ-78436735) (i.e., a single dose).

Students will not be allowed to enter any of CompTIA Tech's campuses until at least two (2) weeks after being fully inoculated with a COVID-19 Vaccine.

Students enrolled in CompTIA Tech's in-person program(s) must provide CompTIA with proof that they have received a COVID-19 Vaccine by registering their vaccine record in the portal. Students must provide such proof prior to attending in-person CompTIA Tech program(s). In providing such proof, students are not to provide any medical or genetic information.

Students requiring an exemption to this Mandatory COVID-19 Vaccination Policy due to a valid medical or religious reason should contact CompTIA Tech at the Senior Manager, Office of Admissions.
